#### **Editorial**

he Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM) is a bold and visionary response to one of the India's key urban challenges. Statistics shows that sanitation has emerged as one of the foremost challenges for the Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) in India. Unlike any other States, in the current time, solid waste management is one of the most challenging issues faced by Jammu Region as well. Due to rapid increase in urbanisation, industrialisation and population, the generation rate of municipal solid waste in the cities and towns of Jammu region has increased enormously. Its mismanagement has caused adverse environmental impacts, public health risk and socioeconomic problems. Due to an increase in population and changes in lifestyle, the quantity and quality of MSW in cities and towns of Jammu region has also changed.

The Directorate of Urban Local Bodies, Jammu is aiming to improve its SWM services by focusing on segregation at source, improving collection and transportation efficiency as well as scientific processing of the municipal solid waste generated in the city. DULB-J is taking steps to sensitize the general public about Solid Waste Management through intensive Information, Education and Communication (IEC) programs. These IEC programmes aim to create awareness among masses regarding solid waste in order to avoid, minimise and manage solid waste and also to discuss models and techniques which can solve many of the current solid waste problems.

# DULBJ STEPS TO MAKE PEOPLE AWARE OF SWACHH BHARAT MISSION

Signed MoU with All India Institute of Local Self Government, New Delhi for conducting IEC activities in ULBs of Jammu Region

he Directorate of Urban Local Bodies-Jammu, is the nodal agency to sanitation where as the DULBJ is the head office supporting and Directing in implimentation in 36 ULBs of Jammu Division. The existing population of the Urban Local Bodies under DULBJ is approx 6.07 Lakh and having a total number of 446 wards. Currently the ULBs are facing various new and second-generation issues related with health, sanitation, waste management which has to be addressed in time bound manner. One of the main reasons is lack of knowledge as well as awareness of scientific and environmentally sound waste management systems and techniques. Hence in October 2022, the Directorate of Urban Local Bodies-Jammu hired the services of All India Institute of Local Self Government (AIILSG) for conducting effective campaign to educate and popularise various environment friendly measures, create enabling environment to bring about an attitudinal and behavioural change in the field of Solid Waste Management and Sanitation for 20 ULBs and the services will be extended in remaining 16 ULBs at the eairlest. The core scope of work of the hired agency is to contribute in building the city image as Green and Swachh (Hygiene) City, through rigorous public/ stakeholder consultation, undertaking IEC activities and undertaking various capacity building exercises besides other supporting activities including conducting baseline survey, bulk waste generator survey, rag picker survey and SS 2023 Documentation related to Waste Management, Sanitation and Health/ Hygiene.

## WET AND DRY WASTE PROCESSING WORKSHOP

n the month of November 2022, the Directorate of Urban Local Bodies, Jammu rolled out one week awareness campaign on processing of dry and wet waste in compliance to Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016.

Composting is nature's process of recycling decomposed organic materials into a rich soil known as compost. By composting your organic waste, you are returning nutrients back into the soil in order for the cycle of life to continue. The Household/Community level waste processing will reduce the load on urban local bodies for collection and disposal of solid waste. This workshop was intended to aware citizens regarding different types of dry and wet waste processing techniques they can adopt at their own premises. The workshop received a positive feedback from the participants.













he Directorate of Urban Local Bodies, Jammu conducted one week awareness campaign on collection of user fees paid towards waste management services to ensure that citizens pay the fees to respective Municipal Councils/ Committees and the cost recovery for SWM services are ensured.

User fee is an important source of revenue for local bodies and would make the operations and maintenance financially sustainable. As per SWM Rules 2016, user fee is to be collected by local bodies for making their SWM operations sustainable.

The main objective of this workshop was to sensitise the ULBs and to strengthen the collection of user fee practices among sanitation workers to improve the quality of waste collection and processing using cost recovery techniques.





## IDENTIFICATION AND ELEMINATION OF GVP

G arbage vulnerable points (GVP) are those areas where the garbage gets piled up because of the constant dropping of garbage by the local residents, travellers, or passerby. The Directorate of Urban Local Bodies, Jammu in the month of November 2022 has taken an initiative to eliminate the GVPs present in the cities and towns of Jammu Region.

During the first week, more than 30 GVPs were identified in the ULBs and sanitation drives were conducted to sensitise the GVPs with the help of sanitation staffs and IEC team.

# WORKSHOP ON 3R's

W aste Management is a serious concern for all emerging developing countries like India. With the rapid economic growth and urban development, waste disposal has emerged as a major environmental Issue in the urban areas of India. Reduce, Reuse and Recycle (3R) of waste is an accepted approach to manage waste in an environment friendly manner.

Waste minimization can be achieved in an efficient way by focusing primarily on the first of the 3Rs, "reduce," followed by "reuse" and then "recycle." A 3R based Solid Waste Management System can only be achieved with a proper stakeholder consultation process starting from central to grass root level. The Directorate of Urban Local Bodies, Jammu with the aim to promote 3R principles organised several workshops at colleges across Jammu division. This workshop was intended to conceptualise the 3R principles to the students and to motivate them to adopt 3R initiatives.






